'Starting the Conversation'



Whatever the age of your children, it's important to keep them safe when browsing websites, using social networking services, gaming and chatting with friends online. Don't get alarmed by the Internet - just keep up to date with current advice

What is sexting?

Sexting is when someone shares sexual, naked or semi-naked images or videos of themselves or others, or sends sexually explicit messages. They can be sent using mobiles, tablets, smartphones, laptops - any device that allows you to share media and messages.

What the law says



Sexting can be seen as harmless, but creating or sharing explicit images of a child is illegal, even if the person doing it is a child. A young person is breaking the law if they:

- Take an explicit photo or video of themselves or a friend.
- Share an explicit image or video of a child, even if it's shared between children of the same age.
- Possess, download or store an explicit image or video of a child, even if the child gave their permission for it to be created.
 Sending a photo or message is easy but we need to remember the sender will then have no
 - control about how it's passed on. When images are stored or shared online they become public. Children and adults may think that images and videos only last a few seconds on social media but they can be saved or copied by others including people you or your child don't know. Children may think 'sexting' is harmless but it can leave them vulnerable to:
- **Abuse**. Sexual images posted online can attract the attention of sex offenders, who know how to search for, collect and modify images.
- **Blackmail**. An offender may threaten to share the pictures with the child's family and friends unless the child sends money or more images.
- **Bullying**. If images are shared with their peers or in school, the child may be bullied and become socially isolated, emotionally distressed and increasingly vulnerable.
