Early Help is the name given to the range of family support services that aim to help and support children and their families. For those of you who have used our Children Centre services in the past, I do need to tell you that due to the changing requirements of the County Council we have had to re-design quite a lot of the service provision to that which we offered previously. It is no secret that local government money is stretched very tight and we need to make sure that we use it as wisely as possible and to get the very best return on the money we spend.

This means that we have to review all existing services as to whether or not they can continue. If they are in our service plans, which a number are, they will continue much as before. If they are not in our service plan, we are looking at whether they can be taken on by other agencies or in some instances the groups can run themselves.

Happy to Be Me

Happy to Be Me is a 5 week programme that takes place within local primary schools across the district. The programme has been specifically designed to help children build and maintain their own self-esteem and selfconfidence.

During the five sessions the children will make a new friend called 'Cog'. 'Cog' just like all children sometimes finds situations and managing his feelings difficult and needs to



identify ways of dealing with these. Cog (a puppet) along with the trained facilitator will use stories, games, exercises, songs, and most of all lots of fun to help children feel good about who they are.
